THE SPIRITUAL JOURNEY IN THE POETRY OF THEODORE ROETHKE

Roethke (1908-1963) saw manual labor firsthand as he grew up in the Saginaw Valley of Michigan where his father and uncle owned and actively managed a complex of greenhouses.
